A Drug Trafficking Ring Uprooted with 240Kg of Ketamine Seized

On May 4th 2011, prosecutors at Banciao District Prosecutors Office (BDPO), joined by law enforcement agencies including military police, telecommunications police force, and local police force, carried out the sweeping raid on a Kaohsiung-based drug trafficking ring and arrested Mr. Lee, the ringleader and 4 other accomplices. Around 240 kg of ketamine, 75,000 NTD cash, a currency counter, a digital pocket scale and various sizes of zipper bags were also found and seized.

To implement The Ministry of Justice's campaign to uproot illegal drugs once and for all, BDPO directed joint police force to trace down sources of drugs. Information indicated that Mr. Lee and his members were trying to smuggle drugs from southern Taiwan for potential buyers in Kungliao Ocean Music Festival, an event held by the northeastern coast of Taiwan. After days of intelligence gathering, the joint force decided to take action and successfully prevented the drugs from reaching our citizens.
